What is an event summary?

An event summary is a clinical document you can upload to:

- provide information about a significant healthcare event (e.g. a new food allergy is confirmed); or
- indicate a change to their health status or condition (e.g. patient confirmed not allergic following a food or drug challenge).

Who can upload an event summary?

An event summary is completed by healthcare providers who are not the patient's regular GP. A healthcare provider can upload an event summary to an individual's My Health Record using [conformant clinical software](#) (e.g. Genie).
